If no one was looking would you steal something?


Do you ever think, my life would be better if I had that bigger piece of cake and gave my friend the smaller one?

Today we are talking about **temptation**. It's when you **want** to do, say or continually think something wrong.

Storytime: The Rejection of Smelldon



A boy name Rightkirk on the playground thinks “Oh there's Smelldon, I will avoid him, cause he smell's weird and has no hair.” And then because Rightkirk is thinking about how smelly Smelldon is, he begins avoiding poor Smelldon. It comes out of Rightkirk's body in **action**. Rightkirk because of what he is **thinking**, has a hardening of **heart** and **rejects** Smelldon by not including him in a game. This is done not by words, but just by not making eye contact with Smelldon, and walking right past him. And there is Smelldon, just waiting, hoping someone will play with him. Rightkirk happily believes he is right to avoid Smelldon by walking past him and not looking at him, after all he did not actually say, “You can't play with us.”

Now let's think about that.

God sees the heart. Have you guys heard that before? Talk about God seeing Smelldon and Rightkirk's hearts in this story.

Do you think Rightkirk did the good thing by avoiding Smelldon?

We were made to be the kind of people who wouldn't even consider rejecting someone based on smelliness, or their past or their funny big toe. We can do this, with God, otherwise it is impossible. And God gives us his spirit, closer than your favourite bunnyhug. The clincher is....we have to want to live that way.

Jesus Is Offered All The Things, and Says “Ah, No Thank-You”

AKA Jesus is Tempted in the Desert Matthew 4:1-11

After Jesus showed his “withness” to God, after being baptized, he went out to an isolated place. There he was tempted by the devil as he ate nothing.

Does your thinking go out of wack sometimes if you don't eat? Watch the video and read how Jesus got what he needed not from food, but from God, who keeps us, even in hard times. And then hard times become easy times.


