Daily Life Questions

Are you going to do something special for your mom or grandma today?

Trinity Thinking

Imagine three persons, God the father, Jesus the son, and the holy spirit. They all are different in what they do, yet they are one. *In the trinity there are more than can be one, yet they are so one in each other, they cannot be divided.*

Imagine you have had a very good friend, parent or employer. You know each other well, yet you are separate people. You know what the other is thinking. You don't have to ask to help them do something, you just do it. No one ever says I am the boss, I am in charge of this or that. There is no fighting for power. There is no rejection. It is one long

“After you. No, after you. No after you.” That is a little glimpse into the perfect companionship that is in the trinity. And it is what we were made for in all our relationships.

Thinking about God's Kingdom, which is here right now, and available.

Do: *Guys, let's touch our toes!*

Imagine a hula hoop. Everything you are responsible is in that hula hoop, that is your kingdom.

Ask: What do you have responsibility over?

Some ideas:

My words to my sister or brother, what I do with my time, how much sleep I get, my red fire truck, my tablet.

Do: Touch your toes to the right! (Did you just take out someone?)

You can take everything you are in charge of, into God's joyous kingdom; it is here right now, it is invisible, and it is closer than the air. We were made to do life with God. This includes thoughts. Experiment with inviting Jesus into everything you do. Try it. He won't be offended. He loves being with you.

What will you invite him into?

What this week would be better done with God?

We can be in conversation with God about what he and I are doing together, that is what prayer is.

Pray: Pray together. *Prayer is just talking to God about what you and he are doing together. There may be a lot of asking.*


