Daily Life Questions

JOHN THE GUY WHO DUNKED PEOPLE IN WATER

AKA John the Baptist

Baptism in water shows our connection to God and with other people who are together with God.

When Jesus came, more than being dunked in water, Jesus showed that we can be totally surrounded inside and out with the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is God's personal power that is always with us. It is invisible.

We don't see the Holy Spirit, God gave us the Holy Spirit to be with us all the time. To help us. To give us power to do what we can't do on our own.

John baptized Jesus in water, and Jesus baptizes us with power, in the Holy Spirit.
